All persons using the pool do so at their own risk and the Hammond Hills Swim and Tennis Club assumes no responsibility for injury or damage resulting from such use. The responsibility of parents and/or adult members who accompany children to the pool continues while the children are in or near the pool and playground areas. The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all users of the pool facilities and are designed to assure safe and sanitary operations of your pool. Members are expected to instruct their children to observe all rules and obey instructions from the lifeguards and other pool attendants. Repeated failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for suspension of privileges and/or a fine.

SAFETY RULES

1. There will be one 10 minute break per hour for adult swim. All children under the age of 16 must be completely out of the pool.
2. The lifeguards and Pool Board Members are in complete charge. Anyone not following the rules will be asked to leave and/or privileges suspended.
3. Glass or other breakable objects are not permitted in any area of the pool, playground, clubhouse, tennis courts, or in the parking areas.
4. The following; are prohibited: running, wrestling, dunking, spitting, ball throwing, horseplay, pushing others, gum chewing, food in the pool, tennis balls in the pool area.
5. No swimming shall be permitted in the diving area except during periods declared no diving by the lifeguard on duty.
6. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time. No hanging or bouncing on the diving board is allowed. Divers must swim to the ladder.
7. Bathers must stay clear and not loiter near the lifeguard chair.
8. Inflated devices, balls, toys and swimming aids may be permitted at the discretion of the pool manager (when considered not dangerous or annoying to other swimmers).
9. Do not tamper with or insert objects in the drains and do not turn on water hoses.
10. The practice of children jumping into the pool after swim meets is not acceptable.
11. An adult must observe any children with water wings or other swim devices while children are in the water or on pool edge.
12. The wading pool is for the use of children 4 years old and under who must be supervised by a parent or other responsible adult.
13. Children under 9 years of age must be attended at the pool by an adult. Unattended children must be able to swim the length of the pool unassisted.
14. Shoes are required on the playground.

HEALTH RULES

1. Do not bring sick children to the pool. If your child becomes ill (throw-up, diarrhea) please notify the Lifeguards immediately.
2. All children who are not potty trained MUST wear watertight swim diaper with elastic at the waist and legs. The changing table must be used for diaper changing.
3. All persons, especially children, are urged to use toilet facilities before entering the pool. It is requested that an adult take young children to facilities to ensure cleanliness.
4. Persons with skin eruptions, open sores, bandages, etc., are not permitted in the pool.
5. Smoking is permitted only in the parking lot. All smoking materials/trash must be placed in proper receptacles.
6. Candy wrappers, cups and trash should be placed in proper receptacles.
7. A lifeguard detecting a chilled or exhausted swimmer shall have the authority to require the swimmer to take a reasonable rest period.
8. Pets are not allowed in any area of the pool, pool grounds, or clubhouse.
9. The pool will be closed for pool shock when necessary. Notice will be posted.

GUEST POLICIES

1. Guests must be accompanied by a member for admittance and member must remain with guest during stay at the pool. .
2. Members must register guests with the lifeguard and pay guest fees. Fees are \$2.00 for each adult, teen or child.
3. A limit of five (5) visits per guest in total will be enforced for the season, no matter how many different members bring a given guest.
4. Out-of-town guests are not charged guest fees

TENNIS RULES

Court Usage

1. Tennis courts are for the exclusive use of the club members and their guests. Guests are allowed on the courts only when accompanied by a member. Members are responsible for their guests.
2. All players must wear regulation tennis shoes only (no jogging, basketball, street shoes, etc.) and must be clothed in generally good taste for tennis play. Shirts must be worn at all times. Bathing suits, cut-off jeans, tank tops & other similar type clothing are not allowed.
3. All members and their guests are requested to observe the rules of tennis etiquette at all times. Use proper walk-ways to get to your court without interfering with other in tennis play.
4. Only players are allowed on the courts (no small children please).
5. Signing up: If you do not sign up you may be "bumped" by others who have signed up (even if they arrived after you did).
6. Members may reserve a court by signing the tennis court play roster located at the clubhouse prior to their scheduled playing time no earlier than 6:00 PM, two days preceding the day of play.
7. Play is limited to one hour for one person for practice; and two hours for singles or doubles.
8. Play must begin within ten (10) minutes of your reserved court time or your court may be claimed by another party who is waiting. -
9. Players must not sign up for more than one court. In addition, players must leave the courts for at least one sign-up period prior to playing again if others are waiting.
10. Adults have priority over players less than 18 years of age after 5:00 PM on weekdays and 2:00 PM on weekends, unless such players are playing with an adult.
11. The court lights automatically cut off at 11:00 PM. If the courts are not in use, please manually cut the lights off.
12. The courts should be locked when not in use. Please lock the gates if you are the last to leave.
13. Please report rule violations and problems to the pool manager.
14. Everyone is asked to carry out and dispose of their own trash during the off-season (Sept-May).
15. Those renting the pool for private parties do not have exclusive use of the tennis courts. The courts will be open to any member who has signed up according to the established procedures unless otherwise approved by the Tennis Committee.

A.L.T.A. Rules

1. A.L.T.A. teams may play out of Hammond Hills with prior permission of the Board.
2. Written applications must be submitted prior to each season and should include a complete roster (w/Hammond Hills members indicated) and desired practice & match times.
3. Fees for A.L.T.A. team play are set each season.

PRIVATE PARTIES

The pool is available any night after closing until 11:30 PM, excluding scheduled general parties, and subject to availability of a lifeguard. The following procedure must be followed for renting the pool facility for private parties:

Pool Parties/Special Events

During regular operating hours, all private pool parties with twelve (12) or more attendees must be submitted to Sears Pool Management (on SPMC's party request form) and cleared with SPMC management at least 7 days prior to the date of the party. Parties with fifteen (15) or more attendees may require an extra guard to be booked, depending on the judgment of SPMC management. This will depend on the day of the party (weekday, weekend, holiday). Pool parties with eleven (11) or fewer guests do not need to be cleared by SPMC management, but we prefer that Club Members give us advance notice of at least 4 days. After hours pool parties are permitted once SPMC receives notice of Client's approval, and if there is sufficient lighting (determined by SPMC management) in the pool area.

If it is determined that an additional guard will be necessary, lifeguards will be staffed, one (1) for every twenty-five (25) individuals. The Club Member will pay SPMC twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per hour for each additional lifeguard necessary, with a minimum fifty (\$50.00) dollars per event. Payment must be received by SPMC at least one day prior to the party date. Client may elect to be invoiced for parties, and handle party fees privately with the Club Members.

An additional lifeguard will be required for all parties where alcohol is served. During all private parties, all children eight (8) and under must be supervised by an adult. Teenage and college age parties must have at least one adult chaperone for each 15 people at the party. Parties that leave a large mess may be subject to penalty charge to cover extra clean-up time.

Club Member may cancel a party with 24-hour notice and receive a full refund. Parties cancelled with less than 24-hour notice will receive a 50% refund. If Club Member wishes to cancel, reschedule or postpone the party, Club Member must contact SPMC at least two hours in advance of the original party time. There will be no additional charge to cancel (with full refund), reschedule or postpone a party due to inclement weather with a two-hour notice.

Any unscheduled parties with 15 or more attendees will be subject to a charge of \$200. If emergency staffing is available and SPMC staffs an unscheduled party at the last minute, the rate shall be \$50/hr per guard. If emergency staffing is not available, SPMC reserves the right to close Pool or cancel party, if the party poses a safety risk. Charges will be billed to Client. Client is responsible for collecting charges from Club Member for breach of party policy.

\SPMC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SHUT DOWN A PARTY IF IT IS SIGNIFICANTLY UNDER GUARDED. PLEASE BE ACCURATE! FOR INSURANCE LIABILITY PURPOSES THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE COVERAGE POLICIES.

Open Season Schedule for Hammond Hills Pool

The Pool shall open for the season May 23rd, 2009. The Pool shall close for the season after September 13th, 2009. The Pool shall be open and guarded as follows:

May 23 - August 9

Monday - Friday	11:00 A.M. - 9:00 P.M.
Saturday	10:00 A.M. - 9:00 P.M.
Sunday	10:00 A.M. - 8:00 P.M.

August 10 - September 13

Monday - Friday	4:00 P.M. - 9:00 P.M.
Saturday	10:00 A.M. - 9:00 P.M.
Sunday	10:00 A.M. - 8:00 P.M.

Except:

Labor Day	10:00 A.M. - 8:00 P.M.

During these guarded hours, one guard shall be on duty, unless otherwise noted. Schooldays are defined as any day in which Fulton county schools are in session or would normally be in session.
